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I 教育活動

○理念・目標・方針・計画(方法)

【理念】

Philosophy

Teachers can play a big role in shaping a student's character and future. Students have a variety of personalities, talents, interests and abilities and good teachers will seek to meet not only the educational/intellectual needs of the students but also their social, emotional, physical, and spiritual needs. Therefore, although teaching is mainly connected to the educational activities of students, it should go beyond the core subject curriculum and also include practices that are character building and useful for practical living, both now and in the future.

I believe that the quality of teaching can have a significant impact on students' behavior and motivation. Motivation is an unconscious, psychological process that varies by individual over time, and its degree usually depends on attitude. Both attitude and motivation are also social processes, and they are influenced by individual experiences and cultural background of students. In my opinion, motivation can be generated through good learning materials and effective teaching strategies. The teacher must gain the students' attention by supplying them with stimulating activities and using a range of teaching strategies.

Teaching at a university grants me an opportunity to help shape students' futures at a time when they are discovering their own identity and desires for their life. Teaching is a consistent, two-way process of learning and sharing. I often learn from my students by getting feedback from them. In addition, I believe it is important for me to talk with my colleagues to get support and feedback, to learn from their experiences, to be open to new methods and strategies, and to seek out professional development opportunities at conferences, seminars, books, and online classes.

Goal

My goal is to improve the students' desire and ability to understand and use English in practical, communicative ways. I want them to be comfortable with foreigners and have a positive attitude toward communication in other languages and a greater respect for other cultures.

【方針】

Policy

I try to display and model a caring and understanding attitude toward the students and carry out my work with enthusiasm and good humor. I try to relate my personal knowledge and life experiences to various topics in our classes in order to increase students' knowledge about the world and improve their language skills. English language ability is a means of learning about the world. A second language is most effectively mastered in a meaningful context. It is also important to teach students how to study. Students do not 'learn' a language; they 'acquire' it. Acquiring a language means that students 'pick up' certain skills, not just memorize information such as grammar rules, vocabulary, phrases and syntactical structures. Acquiring a language involves the physical activities of listening, speaking, reading, writing but communication includes much more such as body language, gestures, facial expressions, and tone of voice. Students need to not only memorize and understand English but also to practice it in authentic ways in order to 'pick up' certain skills.

Student motivation can be a difficult task for the teacher. My students usually perceive the content of my lessons as relevant to their objectives. I try to design learning objectives in such a way as to make them achievable and to continually build my students' confidence. I motivate students by using various strategies such as learner-centered activities, cooperative learning, informal assessments and open communication. I also explain to my students why they need to learn certain things.

In my lesson plans, I use many in-class examples, exercises, homework, and tests that will enable my students to feel more confident in their interactions with English-speakers. I want their learning to be not only interesting but also useful. I also hope to expose students to foreigners in settings outside of the classroom so that they can experience international cultures and languages in real ways. I will conduct myself professionally in a way that models good character, dependability, integrity, and kindness. I will use a variety of materials and technologies to make the classes more enjoyable for the students. My tests will also be a learning experience and not just for assessment.

○教育方法の実践

In 2023 Toho Project class, I asked students to visit places where foreigners meet. I wanted them to have the experience of socializing in English with English-speakers from all over the world in natural real-world settings. I sometimes met the students at such places. Then, the students created

presentations and hosted cafes based on the food and drinks from countries all over the world. This fostered internationalization of the students.

In order to increase students' motivation through gamification, I incorporated a number of quizzes from such websites as Quizziz, Quizalize, and Quizlet. These greatly increased student participation and enjoyment of the classes.

Every week, I actively supported the ESS (English Speaking Society) students circle by playing games with them and creating materials to help them study for the TOEIC test. I hope to involve more international students this year.

I helped plan, create and buy materials for, and participated in lunch time cultural events based on holidays.

I attended the campus festival that was put on by the students.

This is significant, as colleges and universities strive to attract, retain, and engage digitally savvy students who are increasingly demanding engaging, technologically rich, learning environments.
