### ■授業の目的と概要(Course purpose/outline)

Improving your skills in online video games, a competitive sport, or a musical instrument requires constant practice. You cannot just watch YouTube videos or read Instagram posts and expect to suddenly get better. You have to DO it. Learning another language, such as English, is exactly the same. This means that we will actively USE English in every lesson. In this class you will focus on engaging topics/issues that spark critical thinking and meaningful discussion. Each lesson will focus on language practice and speaking skills that will help you to: deepen your understanding of the topics, express your personal point of view, have animated interactions, and give several meaningful presentations. This class is for intermediate level students who understand that English is a tool for communication, are ready to improve their speaking and listening skills, and want to have fun actually using real English.

授業の方法(Class method)	In general, each class will have three main parts:  ① A timed vocabulary activity/quiz, a short listening/speaking warm-up, and group shadowing practice. ② A group discussion/interview to share your opinions and justify them with reasons. There is special focus in this part on extending your responses and expanding on what others have said. ③ Work on presentation skills and prepare for in-class presentations on familiar and interesting issues.
